WHEREAS, TOPS Markets, LLC subleases a portion of the plaza to Benderson Development;										
WHEREAS, Benderson Development has filed tax assessment challenges relating to the property located at 2501-11 West State Street in the City of Olean;										
WHEREAS, the Benderson tax assessment cases pending against the City and School District are for the 2011-2012, 2012-2013, 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 tax years;

WHEREAS, one of three storefronts leased to Benderson has been vacant for some time since Blockbuster went bankrupt and the anchor tenant in the plaza, Tops Markets, has recently negotiated a lease extension with a lower annual rent payment;

\$6,000,000 as well as tax refunds plus retroactive interest for all four years;

WHEREAS, the proceedings seek reductions in assessed valuations from \$6,900,000 to

WHEREAS, Benderson Development has obtained an appraisal from appraiser Howard Schultz valuing the property at \$5,400,000;

WHEREAS, a settlement has been proposed in which the assessment on the property will be lowered from \$6,900,000 to \$6,000,000 for the 2014-2015 tax year and the following three tax years and Benderson Development will withdraw and discontinue the 2011-2012, 2012-2013 and 2013-2014 tax cases and TOPS Markets, LLC will withdraw and discontinue its 2013-2014 tax case

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and both entities will waive all City and School District tax refunds;

WHEREAS, the City Assessor believes the assessment reduction is reasonable based upon the reduced lease payment and storefront vacancy;

WHEREAS, in addition to avoiding potential substantial tax refunds, the settlement will save the City and School District significant litigation and appraisal costs as well as additional financial exposure if the case proceeds to trial; and

WHEREAS, the Olean City School District's legal counsel recommends the approval of the proposed settlement; it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the proposed settlement reducing the assessment on the property located at 2501-11 West State Street in the City of Olean from \$6,900,000 to \$6,000,000 for the 2014-2015 tax year, waiving all School District tax refunds for the 2011-2012, 2012-2013 and 2013-2014 tax years and authorizing the issuance of a revised 2014-2015 school tax bill reflecting the revised assessment, is hereby approved.
