6. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

A. Accountability and Graduation Projections Presentation.

Mr. Andreano and Dr. Morris presented graduation projections for the 2025 school year.

- A Cohort is decided by the year that you start 9th grade, and they can graduate from 4 up to 6 years, which includes several current pathways, including local diploma, Regent's Diploma, and CDOS. You can only be removed from the Cohort by using specific exit codes.
- Olean is Projecting a 91% graduation rate, but that is subject to change as we get closer to graduation.
- Students who drop out, remain in their Cohort. The dropout rate is not inverse of the graduation rate, it
 is coded as a percentage of students who have been coded as "Dropped Out"
- Graduation requires 22 credits, some students get as many as 8 credits per year
- Out of the 114 graduating this year, it is expected to hand out 9 local diplomas, 53 Regent's Diplomas, 41
 Advanced Regent's Diplomas, 4 CDOS Diplomas, 1 student is continuing on and we have 5 drop-outs as
 of the date of this meeting.
- Mr. Andreano shared that students have more than 1,000 dual enrollment class hours (which are being taught at Olean High School); 40 students in BOCES tech programs, 54 student participating in athletics, 38 students in the National Honor Society, 42 enrolled in Music programs and 2 students enrolled in the New Visions Program.
- Over 75% of seniors have applied to the colleges they wish to attend.
- Mr. Andreano shared the interventions used to increase the projected graduation rate and thanked the Board for their support of these programs. One support being APEX Credit Recovery, which allows students to make up credits in order to meet New York State graduation requirements. Students in this program (less than 5) have come from other districts/states.
