Part of the soccer field was sold with the land and he offered, on several different occasions, to allow the district to use the portion of the property he purchased so for soccer games. Mr. Pancio never heard anything back from the District. In January 2013, he asked the Superintendent for a referendum to purchase the rest of the property. Steve requested that the property transaction be handled the same way that the sale of property to Mazza was handled. In June 2014, he requested a referendum again to purchase the Boardmanville property in the same manner the sale of property to Mazza was handled and he never heard back from the Superintendent. Steve noted that a recent legal notice was published and the asking price is too much – more than 1000% of the assessed value. - 2. Bids will be received for the sale of the property in total, or alternatively for the separate sale of two portions of such property, all of which shall be identified in the bidding documents that the administration will prepare for distribution to prospective bidders.
- 3. The minimum acceptable bid price for the sale of the entire property, and the minimum acceptable bid price for the alternative sale of one or both of the portions of the property shall be identified in the bidding documents.
- 4. Any sale of the property in whole or in part shall be subject to contingencies to be set forth in the bidding documents, including approval of the sale by resolution of the Board of Education, approval of the sale by the District's qualified voters, and compliance by the District with the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act.
