2. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

A. Human Resources Specialist Proposal

- The position will be Civil Service / Confidential Managerial
- The goal is to allow the Business Administrator to focus on Budget and Finance / and the Assistant Superintendent of Academic Services to focus more on Curriculum
- The position will focus on hiring, orientation, onboarding and retention of employees
- There is currently a Staff Analysis being put together and will be shared at the March Audit & Finance meeting
- Based on comparable positions in the area, the pay range would be \$50-80K based on experience
- Would like to present to the BOE by March to have it in place by summer

B. 2025-26 Proposed Budget Presentation

Proposed budget for 2025-2026, with a focus on:

- a. Bus Purchases
 - Proposal to purchase 3 full-sized buses so all Olean buses will be owned by OCSD by the end of the 26-27 school year
 - Currently, Portville pays for the buses, insurance, rand epairs with an administrative fee, and we reimburse them
 - Locked in prices this year, and using reserve funds

b. Operations/Maintenance Budget

- Salaries for cleaners, maintainers, substitutes, equipment, utilities, and operating expenses with the maintenance side reduced by bout 2%
- Electric is expected to increase substantially next year
- The current projected budget does not include current contract negotiations

c. Administrative Budget

- Big increase in business administration
- Costs to BOCES for additional programs that we are purchasing
- Legal costs have increased substantially

d. BOCES Budget (excluding Special Ed)

- We have purchased additional services BoardDocs and Frontline Analytics
- We purchase the services and costs are up, but many of these are aidable
- A general increase in the cost of services through BOCES
