Cash Flow

- Jenny reviewed the General Fund cash flow statement through June 2020; she noted it may change slightly
- Waiting for final state aid certification (\$1.2 million has not been received); should be out within the next few days

Cafeteria P/L

- P&L through end of June 2020
- Purchased approximately \$10,000 of inventory from Sodexo which consisted of food and material (cleaning supplies)
- Freezers and coolers cost approximately \$7,900 in repairs; equipment is very antiquated; will be replaced in the next project
- Received USDA grant grant will pay for liaison between district and farmers; will know more in August
- Waiting on May and June meal reimbursements from state and federal governments; calculated numbers booked as a receivable
- Served less meals than anticipated during COVID
- Completely reconciled with Sodexo (except a \$400 bill)
- The P&L does not include the \$30,000 budget transfer from General Fund

Café Meal Prices for 20-21

- Each year district is required to determine price equity meal calculation for student breakfast and lunches; district has not increased meal prices in several years; OIMS/Hs lunch will be \$2.50; Elementary Lunches will cost \$1.70; all breakfasts will cost \$1.30; if prices are not increased, the district will have to subsidize from the Cafeteria Fund
- Adult meal prices are set by state
- Under the CEP each student is entitled to one free breakfast and one free lunch; if they wish to purchase an additional meal, they have to pay full price
- Under CEP, district has to certify that if the reimbursement rate is not enough, the district will subsidize the cafeteria program
- Cafeteria Manager position interviewed yesterday; hopefully will have candidate to recommend at July 28th BOE meeting; position is a civil service competitive
- Salad bar did not break even; cost was only \$2.20; will not have a salad bar; salads will be prepackaged
- Jenny is working on renewing the CEP; the district will get more reimbursement based on poverty level of students that attend Olean Schools

Paul – since the BOE is responsible for approving expenditures he doesn't understand why the BOE would not approve the reopening plan, especially when the BOE has to approve the reopening expenditures
