Cafeteria P&L as of June 30, 2013 – Unaudited

- Net loss is \$18,023.64 (based on the audit and adjusting entry will be made which will bring the deficit to \$16,000)
- \$30,000 is budgeted in the General Fund to offset cafeteria loss; a transfer will be entered
- Students with outstanding balances letters are sent home; automated phone messages are done; in the past the District has taken action through Small Claims Court
