## 5 Year budget scenarios

- Kathy presented three different scenarios (best case scenario to worst case scenarios)
- Given the understanding of staff and the outcome of negotiations the District is on the road to recovery
- There are so many variables at this point (TRS & ERS rates, health insurance premium increase, worker's comp rates, BOCES rates, teacher retirements are due by December 15<sup>th</sup>, transportation costs, currently in negotiations with the OASA, building budgets)

September 30, 2014 and October 31, 2014 Cafeteria Profit and Loss

- Kathy reviewed the October 2014 report
- Meal participation is up slightly due to direct certification

## Transportation Financial Impact - moving the 7th graders to HS

- Kathy reviewed the current 2014 and 2015 ridership eligibility (number of students eligible to ride; number of students that are riding; and current % of ridership
- Reconfiguration of schools (PreK-2 at WW and EV; grades 3 6 at OIMS; and moving 7<sup>th</sup> grade to the High school) would require one additional elementary bus run and an additional three HS/OIMS bus runs
- Bus purchases require voter approval
