- Tax Collection Process
 - Kathy discussed problems the Tax Collector has experienced with the organization the District contacts with to collect taxes
 - o The concensus of the committee is to do an RFP for this service
- Budget Advisory Ad Hoc Committee Update
 - o An update was given by Kathy at the November 19th BOE meeting
- 2014-15 Budget Development Update
 - Transportation Review discussed the current number of runs; runs needed for the upcoming school year as well as the number of buses needed; reviewed transportation analysis spreadsheets;
 - Utility Review reviewed 5 year history of utilities (savings due to new heating system; increase due to new cooling system)

- TRS Rate update received rates last week (project rates for next school year will be 17.25% - 17.75%); Kathy discussed how this will tie into the tax levy calculation formula
- Minimum wage update Kathy noted that minimum wage will be going up; the increase will not impact the 14-15 budget, however, sub rates will need to be increased for the 15-16 budget
