I will be available to chat with students and respond to emails from parent/guardians from 7:55-2:55 every school day. GRADING:

Grades will be calculated using a total points system. All assignments including homework, quizzes, projects, and tests will be assigned a point value. To calculate a student's grade, divide the number of points a student earned by the total number of points possible. I *try* to update my gradebook in Parent/Student Portal at least once a day. Please use this feature to check and monitor your child's grade and average. During a typical marking period, students should expect:

- Homework assignments: 5 nights per week, about 10-20 points each
- Quizzes: 0-2 per quarter, About 50 points each
- Tests: 2-3 per quarter, About 100-200 points each
- Projects and group challenges: when possible, points vary

HOMEWORK:

- Homework assignments are posted weekly on my webpage, sent to parent via email, and sent in a message through ParentSquare.
 - Students will fill out their agendas in class for the week on Monday (or the first day of week).
- Homework is due the day after it is assigned. (As stated in the letter you received over the summer, 100% homework completion is required for this class. I will be contacting parents/guardians when students consistently fail to turn in homework assignments.)
- Revisions can be made on <u>all</u> homework assignments.

- o Students can earn up to full credit back on assignments that are revised.
- Homework is considered late if it is not turned in at the beginning of class.
