

- **★** Ingredients:
- ★ 1-cup flour
- ★ ¼-cup salt
- ★ ½-cup warm water
- ★ 3-5 drops of natural food coloring
- **★** Instructions:
- ★ Mix together the flour and the salt.
- ★ In a separate container, mix water and food coloring.
- ★ Combine ingredients by pouring the water mixture onto the flour mixture.
- ★ Knead together until smooth.
 - ★ If the dough seems too sticky, add more flour until the stickiness is gone.

- **★** Ingredients:
