#### The Pack is Back

- The following plan has been designed in accordance with the New York State Education Health and Safety Guide for the 2021-22 School Year.
- This plan was also developed with guidance from New York State Education Department, Utica National, Centers for Disease Control, Cattaraugus County Health Department, American Academy of Pediatrics.

#### **Education Goals**

Our plan is for all Huskies to return to traditional in-person instruction (5 days a week) for 2021-2022.

- High quality, rigorous educational experience
- Social-emotional learning and support
- Access to all courses/subjects
- Provide extra-curriculars
- Identify and address any closure-related learning gaps
- Ensure equitable access to technology

### Face Coverings and Building Practices

- Face Coverings Everyone will wear a mask when closer than 6 feet and during transitions.
- Face Coverings are mandated on busses for all students and staff at all times.
- Health screening and temperature checks are no longer required on a daily basis.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout the building.
- As always, please remain home if you are not feeling well.

#### **Quarantine Protocol**

- The Olean City School District will follow directives as issued by the Cattaraugus County Department of Health and the New York State Department of Health.
- Should there be a public health emergency declared or students are quarantined, the Olean City School District is prepared to provide remote instruction. Teachers will work with students who are quarantined to provide assignments.
- The Cattaraugus County Health Department will determine who is required to quarantine if necessary.

### **Preventive Practices for Cleaning**

- The Olean City School District will purchase equipment and supplies that allows for the appropriate amount of cleaning on buses, classrooms, cafeterias, offices, restrooms and playgrounds.
- Frequent hand washing and hand sanitizing are expected of all staff and students.

### Social and Emotional Learning and Supports

- Social-emotional support for students and staff is more important than ever.
- Families and students with concerns should reach out to counselors, teachers, or principals for support.
- Our goal is to have children feel a sense of safety, security, belonging, and positivity.

## PreK-3 Elementary Plan

- Student desks will be arranged to promote physical distancing (at least 3ft) in classrooms with mask breaks provided at teacher discretion.
- Students will have assigned seating that promotes physical distancing (at least 3ft) while eating lunch in the cafeterias/classrooms and/or designated space.
- Lockers/Cubby Spaces will be in use while practicing social distancing.
- Outdoor breaks/Recess will be conducted with proper social distancing to promote mask breaks.
- Students will travel with their class to art, gym, music, library, lunch, and recess.
- Visitors will not be permitted in the building unless pre-approved and follow district guidelines.
- Evening events will resume with safety protocols in place.

#### **Olean Intermediate-Middle School**

- Student desks will be arranged to promote physical distancing (at least 3ft) in classrooms.
- Students will have assigned seating while eating lunch in the Cafeteria.
- Lockers will be used.
- Sanitizer will be available throughout the building.
- Visitors will not be permitted in the building unless pre-approved and follow district guidelines.
- Evening events and extracurriculars will resume with safety protocols in place.

# Olean High School

- Student desks will be arranged to promote physical distancing (at least 3ft) in classrooms.
- Students will have assigned seating while eating lunch in the Cafeteria.
- Students will be permitted to carry backpacks; however, lockers will not be used at this time.
- Sanitizer will be available throughout the building.
- Visitors will not be permitted in the building unless pre-approved and follow district guidelines.
- Evening events and extracurriculars will resume with safety protocols in place.

# Meetings

- Student-related meetings will be conducted in-person or digital format (IEP/504 meetings/Conferences).
- Staff meetings will be in person.
- All Board of Education meetings will be in person.
- Safety protocols will be in place for all meetings.

#### Transportation

- Students will be required to sit in assigned seats.
- Facial coverings are required on all busses.
- Cleaning and sanitizing will occur daily.
- Physical distancing is not required on school busses.

#### **Extra-Curricular Activities and Athletics**

- Additional information and guidelines for visitors to attend extra-curricular activities will be provided by OCSD and safety protocols will be in place.
- Additional information and guidelines for visitors to attend athletic events will be provided by Olean Athletic Department in concert with Section VI and NYSPHSAA.
- Quarantine protocols will be followed.

#### **Student Devices**
