






THE DAY SAC SHAVED


FRESHMAN REACHOUT




Four different work shops, "team building" "juvenile justice", "target and "prevention" provide the students with informative, educational presentations, most of which in cluded guest speaker from around the community.






VALEDICTORIAN Benjamin Keller


