If a student does opt to take the May examination, and receive a good enough score, the student may apply for college credits.







This year Mr. Moser expanded his classroom to Cattaraugus and Ellicottville, with the use of Distance Learning.


Distance Learning gives students an opportunity to take courses that are not offered to them at their schools, and gives them the opportunity to communicate with others. They can share their thoughts and ideas.





Freshman Reachout
